No school employee or student shall visit with or discuss business matters of a personal nature with any representative during the hours that school is in session or that the school employee is on duty in the school, except by permission of the principal or the superintendent of schools. Unless otherwise determined by the superintendent of schools and approved by the board of education, a classroom teacher is considered to be in active pursuit of his or her work during the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M.

Any agent, salesperson, or business representative calling on school personnel about school matters such as textbooks, publications of the school, class insignia, athletic equipment, school equipment, school supplies, building and maintenance equipment and supplies, etc., shall first obtain permission from the office of the secondary principal or superintendent of schools before contacting other school personnel.
