

Superintendent Responsibilities

The superintendent of schools' general responsibilities shall include, but not be limited to the following: Maintaining personal, ethical, and professional standards; demonstrating leadership and managerial ability; providing executive service to, and maintaining an effective working relationship with the board of education; promoting positive school-community relationship; providing leadership to the board of education in long and short-range planning; overseeing the effective development of the curriculum, instruction, and in-service programs; and, administering the fiscal and auxiliary services budgets.

The superintendent of schools shall be responsible, within the guidelines established by the board of education, for recruiting and negotiating the employment contracts for prospective principals and all classified personnel. He or she shall oversee the development of a recruitment program for the employment of other certificated personnel. Gage County School District No. 34 shall be an equal opportunity employer.
