

The teachers and administration should constantly evaluate the instructional program. Such evaluation may be expected to lead to recommendations for modifications of practices, changes in content, and new courses.

The board of education encourages and supports the continual review of the school district's curricular offerings and their content.

The local school improvement committee composed of teacher, administrators, board members and community members will be responsible for making recommendations to the school board for changes in curriculum or course offerings.

This school improvement committee will work with faculty committees in the review and development of school curricular materials or changes in course content. This committee will make reports to the whole board of proposed modifications or changes. Changes in class offerings or the curriculum normally occur with recommendations made by the school improvement committee. The board of education shall give final approval to the addition or deletion of any courses to the curriculum.

Course descriptions and/or courses of studies shall be prepared for the board of education by teachers and administrators, for adoption by the board of education.

The administration shall have the responsibility for the general coordination and oversee the formation, review and updating of all courses of studies and course descriptions.

Prior to the addition or deletion of any courses the procedures set forth in AR-6215, Steps For Adding New Courses or Implementation of Experimental or Innovative Programs shall be followed.
