

**Opportunities for Development - Board Members**

Attendance at meetings directly or indirectly related to education or school matters shall be encouraged for the values they have to the school system and the professional growth of board members. The board of education encourages members to examine other school facilities and their programs.

The superintendent of schools shall notify members of the board of education of all relevant scheduled meetings.

All new members of the board of education are encouraged to attend a New Board Member and/or the Nebraska Association of School Boards (NASB) workshop for board members.

The board also encourages attendance of its own members to:

- I. District and state meetings of the Nebraska Association of School Boards (NASB) and the Nebraska Rural Community Schools Association (NRCSA).
- II. Legislative sessions and related activities.
- III. Other local and regional meetings and/or inservice activities.
- IV. National conventions or the National School Boards Association (NSBA) and/or the American Association of School Administrators (AASA) on a rotation basis among the members.
