

Delayed Action on Certain Agenda Items

To promote thoughtful consideration and to allow sufficient time for the gathering of pertinent information, the board of education in its discretion will act upon certain agenda items only at the next regularly scheduled meeting or at a special meeting called for the purpose of acting upon the item. Examples of agenda items that could merit delayed action might be: purchasing of large pieces of equipment or vehicles, modification of or building new structures, changing or developing new policies, or any other item of a significant nature.

Items of an emergency nature which do not appear on the agenda sent to members of the board of education on the Friday preceding any regularly called Monday meeting can be added to the agenda with the approval of a majority of those board members in attendance on the night of the meeting.
