

Gage County School District No. 34, by action of the board of education may accept any devise, bequest, grant, endowment, or donation of real or personal property. The board of education shall review each offer and determine its appropriateness based upon the goals and objectives of the school district.

Gifts, grants, and bequests shall:

- I. Be free of all restrictions unless waived by the board of education.
- II. Be deemed fitting and appropriate.
- III. Be of value to the educational program of the school district.
- IV. Include installation costs unless waived by the board of education.
- V. Not require excessive maintenance or personnel training costs.
- VI. Gifts or donations shall not possess literature or discriminating material discriminating against sex, race, religion, or support a specific political doctrine or sectarian persuasion.
- VII. All donations shall become the property of the school district or the foundation, as determined by the board of education.

Corporate or other private sponsorship of interscholastic activities is governed by Policy 1105, Advertising and Promotion and shall not be considered a gift, grant, or bequest.
