

BODY FLUID SOURCE OF INFECTIOUS AGENTS**AR-4075.3**

The following is a listing of body fluids, possible organisms transmitted in these fluids, and methods of contact.

BODY FLUID SOURCE	ORGANISM OF CONCERN	TRANSMISSION OF CONCERN
Blood: Cuts, abrasions, nosebleeds, etc.	Hepatitis B. HIV Virus, and Cytomegalovirus	Bloodstream inoculation through cuts and abrasions on hands, menstrual.
Feces	Salmonella and Shigella bacteria, Rotavirus, Hepatitis A virus	Oral inoculation from contaminated hands.
Urine	Cytomegalovirus	Bloodstream, oral and membrane inoculation from hands.
Respiratory, Nasal discharge, Saliva	Mononucleosis virus, Common cold virus, Hepatitis B virus.	Oral inoculation from contaminated hands. Bloodstream inoculation through bites.
Vomitus	Gastrointestinal virus, e.g., (Norwalk agent Rotavirus)	Oral inoculation from contaminated hands.
Semen	Hepatitis B, HIV, Gonorrhoea.	Sexual contact.
