

Voting for an Executive Session.

Any member of the board of education may request an executive session. When an executive session is requested it shall require the immediate action of the entire board of education.

- I. The approval of a motion to enter into an executive session shall require a vote of the majority of those board members present.
 - A. The purpose for the action to enter into an executive session must be stated prior to the vote.
 1. During the executive session the board of education shall either retire to a secluded conference area or request all personnel within the meeting room to be removed during the executive session.
 - B. No notes or recording devices shall be used during the executive session.

Action Following the Executive Session.

- I. When the executive session has concluded the president shall announce to all present during the executive session that the session has been concluded and the board of education is now ready to return to the open meeting.
 - A. Action to return to the open meeting shall require a majority vote of those board members present during the executive session.
 1. Any topic requiring approval by the board of education shall be taken only after the board of education has reconvened in open session. The board of education shall not take any formal action during an executive session.
 2. No member of the board of education shall be excluded from an executive session.
 3. Any member of the board of education shall have the right to challenge the continuation of an executive session if he or she feels that the executive session has exceeded the reason for entering into

the executive session or for (i) the protection of the public interest or (b) the prevention of the needless injury to the reputation of an individual. Such challenge may be overruled only by a majority vote of the members of the board of education in attendance of the executive session. Such challenge and its disposition shall be recorded in the minutes. (Note: Since no official action can be taken during an executive session any action taken on a challenge to continue an executive session must be taken during an open session.)
